



W.A. 2017 Modern Pentathlon/Tetrathlon State Championships

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Expression of Interest for the **Inaugural W.A. Modern Pentathlon/Tetrathlon State Championships** to be held in **Perth** on the weekend of **May 6th and 7th 2017**.

The ride will be on Saturday, hosted by the **Swan Valley Horse and Pony Club**

The other phases will be held on the Sunday, hosted by the **U.W.A. Fencing Club**. The swim will be held at Claremont Aquatic Centre (50m pool).

The following events are available:

1. Modern Pentathlon (UIPM) – Ride, Swim, Fence, Combined (Run/Shoot)
2. Tetrathlon (Pony Club Style) – Ride, Swim, Run, Shoot (Laser Pistols 10m)
3. Tetrathlon (UIPM) – Swim, Fence, Combined (Run/Shoot)
4. Triathlon (UIPM) – Swim, Combined (Run/Shoot)

*There will be Laser Pistols and Fencing Equipment available for Hire for those who need

*The Ride will be a Show Jumping round for both Pentathlon and Tetrathlon Events. There will be no Gate or Slip Rail for the Tetrathlon Course.

* There will be a NOVICE Modern Pentathlon Class for those who have never competed in a full Modern Pentathlon before (Age divisions and height of Show Jumping to be determined once entry numbers and riding competencies/preferences are known).

*There will be a MASTERS Tetrathlon Class for both Tetrathlon types if enough entries are received. Show Jumping (Height will be either 45 or 65cms depending on entries and riding competencies).

*Owners/Riders who offer Pool Horses for the Modern Pentathlon Event will receive a Cash payment

*Tetrathlon Riders will ride at a specific height BEFORE the Pentathlon Riders ride at the same height, so Tetrathlon Riders who are willing, will be able to offer their mount as a Pool Horse for a Modern Pentathlon rider for the same height (or higher) Pentathlon Class.

Jumping Heights for all Classes (except MASTERS Tetrathlon (Horse)) will be as follows:

MAXIMUM height: 65cms, 80cms, 90cms, 1.00m, 1.10m, 1.20m

*For 'YOUTH A' Modern Pentathlon at the W.A. State Pentathlon/Tetrathlon Championships the Riding Points WILL count towards final placings and medals, but not for Australian Ranking points. Placings in Youth A without the riding points will be used for ranking purposes.

*Modern Pentathletes **in Youth A who don't wish to ride will be entered in the Tetrathlon (UIPM) Event.**

* The Show Jumping section on Saturday on Saturday 6th May will be held at the Swan Valley Horse and Pony Club Grounds (SVHPC) – on Swan Fields (at the State Equestrian Centre (SEC), Cathedral Avenue, Brigadoon – Pony Club is located behind and adjacent to the main SEC stable, arenas and rear parking area)

*If you are intending to book a stable/s at the SEC, please do it early as the WA State Dressage Championships are on the same weekend.

*There will be yards at SVHPC but top yards near the Club House will be used by the Pony Club on Sunday May 7th for a Rally so only the yards further away from Club House (end yards) are available for overnight use if needed.
